- A demonstrated love of reading and writing;
- A commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion;
- Experience with students ages 6-18, including students with special needs, English Language Learners, and students from diverse racial/ethnic/economic/religious backgrounds;
- Detail-oriented; able to confidently multi-task and oversee several projects simultaneously;
- Excellent editing, copyediting, and organizational skills;
- A holistic, strengths-based, individualized, and developmentally-appropriate approach to serving individual students and their families;
- Keen observation skills;
- Creative problem-solving skills in translating student information into interventions;
- Comfort mentoring interns and teen staff and delegating tasks;
- A demonstrated willingness to continuously improve as an educator;
- Strong Microsoft Office and/or Google Drive suite skills;
- An understanding of systematic and other challenges facing students in underserved communities and believes in the mission of 826 Boston to alleviate them;
- Fluency in Spanish, Somali, or Arabic highly preferred but not required.

What you'll do:

- Conduct assessments and observations related to literacy and academic and social/emotional learning skills;
- Monitor and promote regular attendance in After-School and Evening Tutoring programs; refine and manage enrollment and recruitment systems;
- Manage the administration of surveys and collection of additional student skills-related data;
- Seek and utilize parent/student/teacher input to inform interventions;
- Develop and implement a system for communicating areas of focus and interventions to volunteers on an ongoing basis;
- Develop and implement metrics for measuring impact of interventions;
- Implement independent and social reading, writing, academic, leadership, and safety initiatives in After-School and Evening Tutoring Program, with a focus on diversifying



- offerings and engaging students of different ages;
- Identify students' individual reading preferences and areas of interest;
- Support Field Trip program via the publishing of books one day per week and train volunteers for specialized roles during field trips;
- Support the Evening Tutoring program session for teens one evening per week;
- Recruit and coordinate students to serve on the Editorial Board for book publishing
- Support families by connecting them to resources to support student engagement;
- Report on tutoring program goals and highlights quarterly.

Benefits of AmeriCorps service:
