826 Boston recruits a group of enthusiastic, dedicated interns for the fall, spring, and summer semesters. Interns will work individually and collectively with each other, our staff of nine full-time employees, and a large group of volunteers.

After School Planning and Operations interns join 826 Boston's Out-of-School-Time Team, supporting staff in researching curricular content, assisting with data collection, compiling tutoring strategies, and preparing new initiatives for 826 Boston's after-school tutoring program. This is an opportunity to create programming for students of all ages, conduct creative arts curriculum research and evaluation, learn about the day-to-day operations of a small non-profit, and join the network of national 826 chapters while building job skills, advancing your resume, and acquiring excellent references. Applicants must be over the age of 18 but need not be currently enrolled in an academic program.

After School Planning and Operations interns commit to 16 hours per week of unpaid work for a minimum of three months. Named one of GOOD magazine's "30 Places We Want to Work," 826 Boston is a vibrant work environment, bustling with staff, interns, students, and volunteers.
