- Collect educational sources for volunteer training on supporting K-8 students, high school students, and teachers, including cultural responsiveness, social-emotional learning, inclusion, and cultural sensitivity
- Review data from feedback surveys/evaluations and develop improvement plans based on outcomes
- Support program team with planning tutor debriefs and creating daily exit tickets to measure quality of tutoring session
- Identify and build relationships with prospective best-fit partners and collaborate on small projects
- Coordinate team of volunteer recruiters to develop and implement outreach plan to recruit
