About the Boston Teachers Union School (BTU)

The Boston Teachers Union (BTU) School is a Boston Public Elementary and Middle School located in the Forest Hills neighborhood. The school is a shared leadership school, and does not have a principal but instead operates under a faculty-led committee structure.

Public Transportation:

The BTU is a 10-minute walk from the Forest Hills stop on the Orange Line.

Parking:

Non-residential parking is limited on surrounding streets. Pay attention to Resident Parking and Street Cleaning notices.



Accessibility

The BTU's main entrance is up a flight of stairs. There is a wheelchair ramp on the side of the school that leads to the basement w/ elevator access (advanced notice is required for 826 Boston staff to gain access to the elevator keys).

Two single-occupancy, unisex/gender-neutral restrooms are located up a flight of stairs in the Teachers' Lounge.

A water fountain and microwave are available for volunteers to use.

Check-In Procedure:

Enter the school using the staircase that faces Wachusett Street. The doorbell is the newer-looking buzzer next to the doors. Visitors must sign in using the guest binder in the Main Office. The Main Office is to the right once you enter the building.

The Writers' Room is located downstairs. Use the staircase near the Main Office, then the Writers' Room will be the first door on your left.
