


The Edward M. Kennedy Academy for Health Careers: Lower Campus

About the Edward M. Kennedy Academy for Health Careers (EMK)

The Edward M. Kennedy Academy for Health Careers is a college preparatory and vocational public high school for Boston students exploring careers in health and health-related professions. The Lower Campus designation refers to freshmen and sophomore year students that this location serves.

Public Transportation:

EMK Lower Campus is accessible through the 39 and 66 bus routes as well as the Orange line (Huntington Ave and Fenwood Road) and the E Green Line (Fenwood Road Stop).

Parking:

There is very limited publicly accessible parking around EMK Lower Campus. Some public lots are available with pass purchase. Public Transportation is encouraged.



Accessibility:

Gender neutral bathrooms are available upon request (key needed) and a teachers lounge with appliances is accessible to all volunteers.

Check-In Procedure:

After entering the building through the main entrance, you will contact a designated point person to meet you at the front of the building. You will then check-in with the main office and receive a guest-pass and name tag in advance of the pre-briefs.
